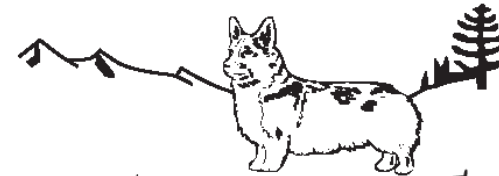

Greeley KC Breeders Showcase: To honor and recognize the many breeders who have supported our show over the past 50 years, on Friday evening, August 19, 2016, Greeley Kennel Club will host our first Breeders Showcase. This event will spotlight breeding programs by focusing on the quality of the dogs produced.

Dogs entered must be of the same breed and presented in groups of 3, with at least two of the three dogs entered from different litters The breeder entering the trio must be the breeder of record on all 3 dogs and must be the first handler for the trio. Entry fees will be \$10 per trio and can be pre-entered or entered the day of competition

Competition will be at the group level and all 7 groups are eligible. Monetary awards and rosettes will be awarded with first group placements at \$150, Best in Showcase will be \$500 and Reserve Best in Showcase at \$250.

BISS: Best in Specialty Shows to be held Saturday, August 20, after Best in Show: All Best of Breed winners from breed specialties Thursday through Saturday are eligible to enter BISS. Breeds holding more than one specialty can have multiple entries. The judge for this event will not have judged any event for the weekend before the competition. NOTE: Twelve-to-Eighteen month class is not a puppy class and requires an adult entry fee.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dog Class: A class for Dogs seven (7) years or older

Veteran Bitch Class: A class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at independent Specialties.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Get must be entered in another class at this show. It is not necessary for the Get to be under the same ownership as the Stud Dog. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed bitches are allowed to be entered in Stud Dog or Brood Bitch.

Brace Class: A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. BOTH DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first-place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first-place awards in a Novice Junior Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Master Class - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

*A recording fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 per entry AKC Event fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Ch. 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT FEES IN US FUNDS. No Cash.

No entry may be sent by any method that requires a signature for delivery.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of a Show Committee.

Post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The PWCCR will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in them being put on a CASH ONLY basis. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike and/or any other cause beyond the control of the PWCCR or Show Secretary.

Exhibitors are responsible for calculating entry fees; refunds due to exhibitor error are at the option of the club. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information in the entry blanks.

Entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form, or photocopy of the Official AKC Entry Form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side, or they cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in completing entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations after the published closing date.

Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog, provided they are 18 years old and neither own nor co-own the dog.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility to children.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging, and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club, nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

City of Greeley Ordinance – Dogs are not allowed in any city park except Island Grove Park.

Unawarded Sweepstakes or Veteran Sweepstakes class placement prize money, from classes with less than four entries, will be divided equally among the Sweepstakes class placements. The division of unawarded prize money will not include prize money not awarded due to absences.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the show, none will be mailed.

The use of flexi-leads on the show grounds, indoors and outdoors, during show hours (6:00am to 6:00 pm) is prohibited.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, Thursday, August 18, Friday, August 19; Saturday August 20, & Sunday August 21. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday August 21.

The grounds at this show include the show buildings, outside show grounds, and all parking areas. There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

Overnight parking will be available beginning at 5:00PM on Wednesday August 17. Anyone wanting to camp in the park prior to this time will need to pay an additional fee to the City of Greeley 525 N15th Ave., 7:00 am to 3:30 pm (fees are per day from \$15.00 to \$25.00). You will be asked to move your rig, if not in your reserved spot on Wednesday at 5:00 pm.

No Grooming set-ups on grassy areas immediately adjacent to the events center.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including those in the Premium List, but not limited by them.

Grooming area is set up under the supervision of the Building Grounds Committee, who may require rearrangement of exhibitor's set-ups where space is not utilized. All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates or exercise pens, except when being judged.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and have appropriate vaccinations.

Crates must be stacked when ever possible in all grooming areas.

Reserved grooming space is available in the air conditioned Exhibition Building, free grooming is available in the Livestock Building. Exercise Pens may be set up in the Livestock Building. Information for reserved grooming is in the GKC show premium available at WWW.ONOFRIO.COM.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions at, and around their set-up area.

Dogs may be exercised ONLY in designated areas outside the building.

NO CRATING OR GROOMING IN THE OUTDOOR PICNIC PAVILION.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Pooper-Scoopers will be placed around the show grounds. If your dog soils in the show ring, the stewards will hold your dog while you do the clean-up.

Crates may be set up in chalked areas only during breed judging and must be removed when judging for that breed is over. No setups will be allowed in the building. NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited.

NO unentered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds during show hours.

No generators to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.

Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

Parents are solely responsible for their children, and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety. No baby strollers in the show buildings.

PARKING REGULATIONS

PWCCR and/or GKC reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate any way necessary. PWCCR and/or GKC solely determines if said animal is in distress. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

No double parking anywhere on the show grounds.

No vehicles will be allowed to enter the park between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. No dogs outside vehicles between 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

All parking is subject to control of the Greeley Kennel Club. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles must be kept clean at all times.

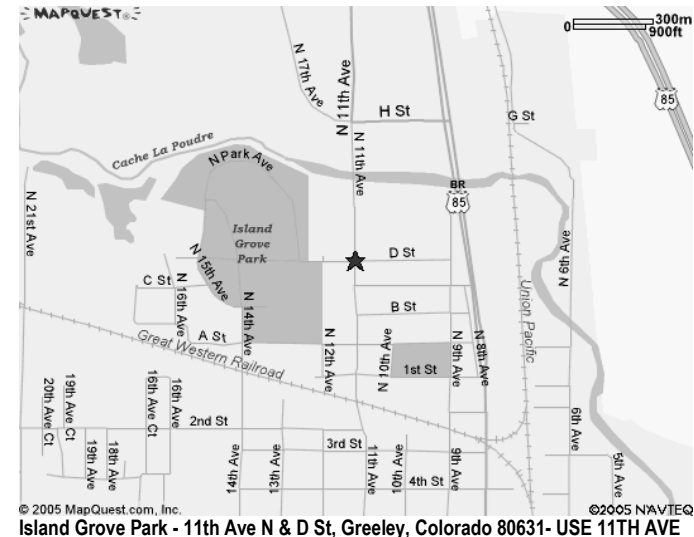
